

Public and private find Common Ground

Internet project management business ProjectCentre and construction company Grocon have joined forces to support Common Ground, a joint initiative between the Federal and state governments to provide much-needed housing. The initiative, A Place to Call Home, aims to build 750 new homes throughout Australia for individuals and families experiencing homelessness.
